You must include a copy of the CLS Trainee license with your application to the CLS program.

- 2. The SFSU Graduate Division requires the following documents to apply to the university:
 - a) Original foreign transcripts.
 - b) A TOEFL test which has been taken within the 2 years prior to application. The minimum TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) score is 550 (or 213 for the computer-based test) for students whose native language is not English or as required by the SFSU Graduate Division.
